Total Health Care's Pharmacy & Therapeutic Committee met in December, 2011 and made the following updates:

As of January, 2012 Total Health Care will be making the following changes regarding the HMG-COA Reductase Inhibitor **Lipitor (Atorvastatin)**:

Total Health Care Medicaid/MiChild	Total Health Care Commercial
Covered after a step therapy with Simvastatin 5mg-40mg	Added to the formulary.

This will be replacing the Hyperlipidemic agents **Crestor** and **Vytorin**, which have been removed from all THC formularies. Members with previous prescription history will be grandfathered for **Crestor/Vytorin**.
